

UKOPA COMPETENCY & TRAINING WORK GROUP

Progress Report – September 2001

- The Competency Framework has been reviewed in detail by the C&T WG. The Group considers that in order to facilitate practical application, role descriptions defined in terms of activities and tasks need to be introduced.
- Role descriptions for Pipeline Engineering Supervisors and Technicians in terms of responsibilities for maintenance and HS&E activities have been drafted (Attachment 1).
- Tasks contained in Section 2 of the Competency Framework document have been aligned to activities in the role descriptions. A Task Register has been produced to replace the existing Section 2 (Attachment 2).
- Core skills, which encompass the practical knowledge required to carry out tasks to a required competency are being identified and included in the Task Register.
- A high level overview of the database requirement has been developed. Development of the database has been postponed to enable more accurate specification.
- The work programme presented in June has been revised for approval.
