All,

Following consideration of the draft ACoP and Guidance document and receipt of comments, the next action was to incorporate the agreed text into a document which separately identified the Regulations, ACoP and Guidance text using (as far as possible) HSE's preferred format (ie the PSSR 2000 model).

Alan provided an electronic form of the proposed amended regulations and HSE draft guidance This is attached (as Psramend0902b.doc). Note, the preferred format is Regulations – bold italics, ACoP – bold text, Guidance – normal text.

I have incorporated text from the draft ACoP and Guidance document, circulated in September. This draft has been reviewed by the UKOPA EPWG, and is attached (as RegACoPGuid\_V3.doc) for your comment and amendment, before formal submission to HSE for consideration for publication as a consultation document. In order to meet the target timescale for publication (Quarter 1 2003), could you provide comments and/or confirmation of support by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December?
