Name	-	Name of the substance. This may not be the synonym by which the substance is known by some Competent Authorities. Names in <b><i>Bold Italics</i></b> indicate that the substance has been selected as one of the preliminary 21 AETL case-study substances. Names in <i>Italics</i> indicate that the substance was proposed by a Competent Authority as one of their initial 10 substances of interest.
CAS #	-	The Chemical Abstracts Service Registry number for the substance to assist in identification of substances known by more than one name. ( <a href="http://www.cas.org">http://www.cas.org</a> ).
UK priority	P1 P2 P0	UK post-ACUTEX prioritization case study High priority. Priority. Not a priority. These substances are included for information as important precursors leading to reaction products which are priority substances.(e.g. sodium cyanide is a precursor leading to hydrogen cyanide exposure).
UK priority basis	R(E)	Risk except where marked R (E) for Exemplar substance.
