Phill,
Can you please circulate to UKOPA members.

I have been contacted by an Emergency Planner from Cheshire to request information which will enable the Local Resilience Forum to assess the risk of a fire or explosion at an onshore fuel pipeline which they say is required under their duties to carry out risk assessments under the Civil Contingencies Act 2004: My initial response was to advise her to wait until PSR 96 was reissued but that does not seem to fulfil the need.

I have asked for clarification and had a discussion and attached is the information I have received. It is probable that other pipeline operators have received similar requests and the UKOPA RAWG are prepared to review, liaise and issue guidance as to what should be provided, recognising that different Local authorities will inevitably have differing requirements.

The RAWG are meeting next on 18th Sept 2008 and would appreciate any comments or feedback from members
