Progress since February Meeting

- ❑ Pipeline operators have sent further data for Faults and updated Pipeline data for 2010 – now collated into data sets available for analysis
- ❑ National Grid (UKT and UKD) have confirmed that the final data download from GL in December 2011 is the completed data set, and have agreed that the GL web-based system can be dis-continued
- ❑ Data downloaded from GL is now archived for future reference
- ❑ Data collection for UK's EGIG data was collated and sent to Robert Owen in July 2011
- ❑ 2-yearly leak report draft version has been completed, and will be approved by FDMG and RAWG before issue – propose to include summary of Fault Data and Weibull parameters for External Interference predictive modelling

Future Plans

- ❑ Revise and issue 7th UKOPA Leak Report for data statistics up to and including 2010
- ❑ Audit and approve data collection, storage and processing arrangements for Excel-based database going forward
- ❑ Update database for changes during 2011 – issue new sets of pipeline and fault data to operators
- ❑ Prepare package of data and procedures for managing the database, arrangements for checking and approval of new data, and security of data
- ❑ Prepare Scope of Work for managing the database – issue Scope for tenders to suitable organisations – review proposals – by end March 2012
- ❑ Place contract for management of database starting April 2012
- ❑ GIS data from HSL
