



- Initial development including
  - Production of Decision Trees
    - Missed Section, Known Unsurveyable, Inaccurate Section
  - Inclusion of Prioritisation Matrix
    - Survey Prioritisation based on Asset Health data
  - Further expansion of the initial draft
    - Alternative techniques, further considerations
- Information to be redrafted into a more 'user friendly' version, but the end of the year for publication in Q1 2025


# Programme of Work

- Ofgem agree to look to make changes




