

A steel chisel fell from height on Queen Elizabeth at the Sponson 4 Catwalk area and fell approximately 20 metres onto the Woolston Barge below. No one was injured.

Immediate control measures
Area was cordoned off and work on the barge was suspended.
Action Required
Risk assessment states no work to be undertaken above area where barge is berthed, investigation underway to establish how/why the chisel fell.
