


Welcome to UKOPA.

The network of pipelines operated by the UKOPA member companies is over 27,000 km in length (nearly 5 times the distance between London and New York). As well as supplying the gas that heats our homes and the gas used to generate electricity in our power stations, these pipelines transport fuel for cars and aircraft and other products. The oils and chemicals transported through these pipelines are also used in countless products that we all use every day in our homes. An evening of networking followed, before a second day packed with informative and insightful presentations on how the pipeline sector is 'Fuelling the net zero future'.




